LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

The official language of instruction is Serbian. . However, there is a case of complete study programs **in English** (e.g. undergraduate program English language and literature study programme at the Department of Philology) or of some courses that could be provided in English (depending on the number of students). Foreign students will be offered consultations and literature in English in order to fulfill the obligations stipulated in their Learning Agreements. International Officers and Academic Coordinators at departments will provide more information about this.

The academic calendar of the State University of Novi Pazar is as follows:

Note: Students are advised to arrive a week or two before the beginning of semester in order to complete all the necessary paperwork and when necessary find accommodation. Expected date of arrival is 15 September (+-3 days) for winter and 15 February for summer semester.

Within the Republic of Serbia higher education system, a 5 – 10 grading scale is used (5 as fail, 6 passing grade and up to 10 for excellent performance).
